GUIDE FOR TEACHERS

This guide is meant for the Teacher-In-Charge (TIC) or parents, the one who submits the registration form and is responsible to conduct IMONST 2021 in the school or home. Please be noted that there can only be ONE TIC for each school. However, the TIC may get help from other teachers to organize and invigilate students during the competition.

Distributing the Contest Slip :

The TIC is responsible to distribute the Contest Slip to all participants. We recommend you to print out the Contest Slip and distribute the hard copy of the Contest Slip to each participant. However, you may also use WhatsApp or email to distribute the Contest Slip in soft copy.

IMPORTANT!

THE CONTEST SLIP IS UNIQUE AND CONFIDENTIAL – PLEASE MAKE SURE PARTICIPANTS DO NOT RECEIVE THE CONTEST SLIP FOR ANOTHER PARTICIPANT. IF YOU USE WHATSAPP, DO NOT SHARE ALL CONTEST SLIPS IN A GROUP CHAT; INSTEAD, DISTRIBUTE THEM INDIVIDUALLY TO EACH PARTICIPANT.



During the competition :

- The competition will be opened from 10AM of 14th August 2021, and will be closed on 10AM of 16th August 2021.
- The participants are allowed to sit for the competition at school or at home based on each participating school's instructions.
- As per other examinations and competition, participants should NOT be given/receive any help from anyone else throughout the duration of the competition.
- If there are not enough computers in the school, the TIC is allowed to put participants into batches. However, participants who have sat for the competition should be quarantined; they should not have contact with those who have not taken the competition.

After the competition :

- The IMONST 2021 results will be announced in 31st August 2021 at www.contesthub.my.



HOW TO PARTICIPATE

Part I: Log-In & Personal Info

1. Go to the main competition page at imonst.imo-malaysia.org. Click on the **Login** button.



2. At the Login page, enter the **Username** and **Password** that has been given. Then, click on the **Login** button.
Note: Check the Caps Lock, and type the password correctly.

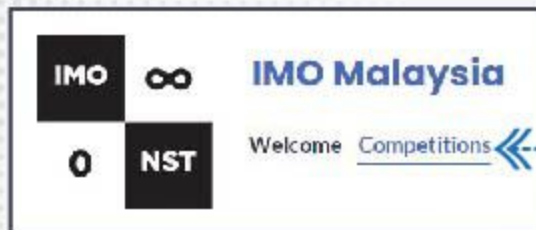

4. If you click on a problem link, the top of the page will show the following. The name of the question and time will be displayed.

Note: Once you have started the contest, the timer will start and will continue to run even if the participants log out or turn off the browser. The timer will stop after 150 minutes. Participants are advised to answer all questions in the given time.

5. The list on the left side of the screen shows the list of the questions. You may also click on any question if you wish to jump straight to that specific question. Once you have finished answering all the questions, click **End** button.

Note: If you do not click "End" before the time limit expires, then the contest will end automatically after 150 minutes.

6. Click **Yes** button to end the contest.

7. Once you have finished the contest, you will see **Challenge Completed** next to your category.

FAQS



How many times can a participant log in to the system to take part in the competition?

A participant can only take part once and this will be counted when they have started the competition timer.

What will happen if a participant starts answering less than 150 minutes before the competition period ends?

The competition will end at exactly 10PM of 16th August no matter the circumstances. Therefore, we suggest that participants should take advantage of the 60 hours window and start answering the questions much earlier.

What will happen to the timer if I am logged out?

If a participant is logged out, the timer will still continue. The participant can still continue answering by logging in using the same username and password, as long as there is still time left on the timer. Participants can end the competition before the time is up, but there will be no extra points for finishing early.

How many times can a participant answer a particular question?

They can change or erase answers as many times as they want before the time is up. They may leave the questions unanswered too.

Participants accidentally started the competition before their planned time. Is it possible to reset their timer or to receive a new username and password?

No.

Can participants view their score immediately after ending the competition?

No score will be shown after the competition ends. All results will be announced in September 2021 through ContestHub.
